Current Issues

- Implementing the latest SBA rules requires EXPRESS to assign the primary NAICS at the Task Order level.
- This is a major change to the way EXPRESS does business and significantly affects the business size of the majority of EXPRESS contractors.
- The small business pool will be inadequate to set aside actions for small businesses in all domains.
- EXPRESS will mitigate the impact by using small business reserves where possible.

Path Forward

- New TORFQ's must now identify the GSA Special Item Numbers required for the effort and the NAICS that represents the preponderance of the work (NAICS must align with the SINs identified)
- Requirements will be assessed to determine if they can be met using Small Business (SB) Reserves.
- Under SB Reserves, EXPRESS will require that small business be assigned at least 50% of the work (all small businesses on the team must meet the NAICS size)

GSA Support

- GSA is expediting the process of adding SINs and labor categories
- Expedite process typically takes 60-75 days (with a quality offer)

Evergreen

- Two phase process involving renewal of the current BPAs and immediate on-ramping to add new small businesses in multiple domains
- Anticipated release of initial on-ramping RFQs in 1st Qtr FY 18 *
- Size certification at BPA level *
- 5 year award term *

- AMRDEC WDI Requirement

 - OASIS Pool 4
 - Currently out for bid, anticipated amendment forthcoming to extend RFP due date and additional 30 days

OASIS

Huntsville Requirements (cont)

- C-RAM Requirement
 - Technical, logistics, and program management support services for the C-RAM System-of-Systems (SoS).
 - OASIS SB Pool 3
 - Currently undergoing final internal (GSA) review prior to RFP issuance. May possibly move from CPFF to T&M contract type

Huntsville Requirements (cont)

- PM ASE Engineering Services Requirements
 - OASIS Pool 3 (no decision on SB or Unrestricted)
 - Industry Day held March 2017
 - Revising the PWS based on Industry Day comments
 - Draft RFP forthcoming

OASIS

Huntsville Requirements (cont)

- PM ASE Programmatic Services Requirements
 - RFI issued in March 2017
 - Draft RFP release anticipated in Mid July
 - Final RFP anticipated 30 days afterwards
 - Still in planning phase, but anticipated to be an OASIS task

OASIS

On-Ramping Opportunities

- OASIS / OASIS SB On-Ramping
 - OASIS SB Pool 2 - closed 26 Jan 2017
 - Additional on-ramps anticipated in conjunction with required OASIS SB size recertifications in 2019
 - OASIS process allows for OASIS SB contractors to transition to OASIS Unrestricted contract
