Provide unmatched logistics support to the Army and the Joint Warfighter through an agile, resilient, diverse, and inclusive workforce.





- Sustainment Logistics support to aviation and missile program management (PM) offices. Execution of secondary-item management, including demand & supply planning, repair program management, inventory management, requisition fulfillment, movement, and disposal of materiel.
- Industrial Operations support to provide an executable and supportable schedule to the organic sustainment-level maintenance provider (both depots and National Maintenance Programs [NMP]) that meets customer requirements.
- Field and Limited Sustainment Maintenance and logistics in support of Army and COCOM requirements worldwide; obsolescence mitigation, management and repair of B64 items. Management and sustainment of deployable aviation support equipment and mission equipment sets.
- Acquisition Logistics support to aviation and missile program management (PM) offices to shape an optimized weapon-system support strategy.






### **M&S Logistics Directorate**








### **Materiel Management Directorate**







### **Current Initiatives**

#### Continued implementation of Sales & Operations Planning (S&OP)

- Identify current/future workload requirements and assess availability of Organic Industrial Base (OIB) capacity
- Achieve 100% materiel forecasting and supportability ("Plan for Every Part")
- Synchronize Depot Modernization initiatives to ensure alignment between system requirements and the Army's timeline/investments for facilities, manufacturing capabilities/tooling, and skilled labor
- Partner with industry to sustain Supply Availability, surge readiness, and exploit new technologies
- Working with the depots to understand planned revenue and workload impacts from reduced contract authority (CA) funding
- Identifying impacts from reduced CA
