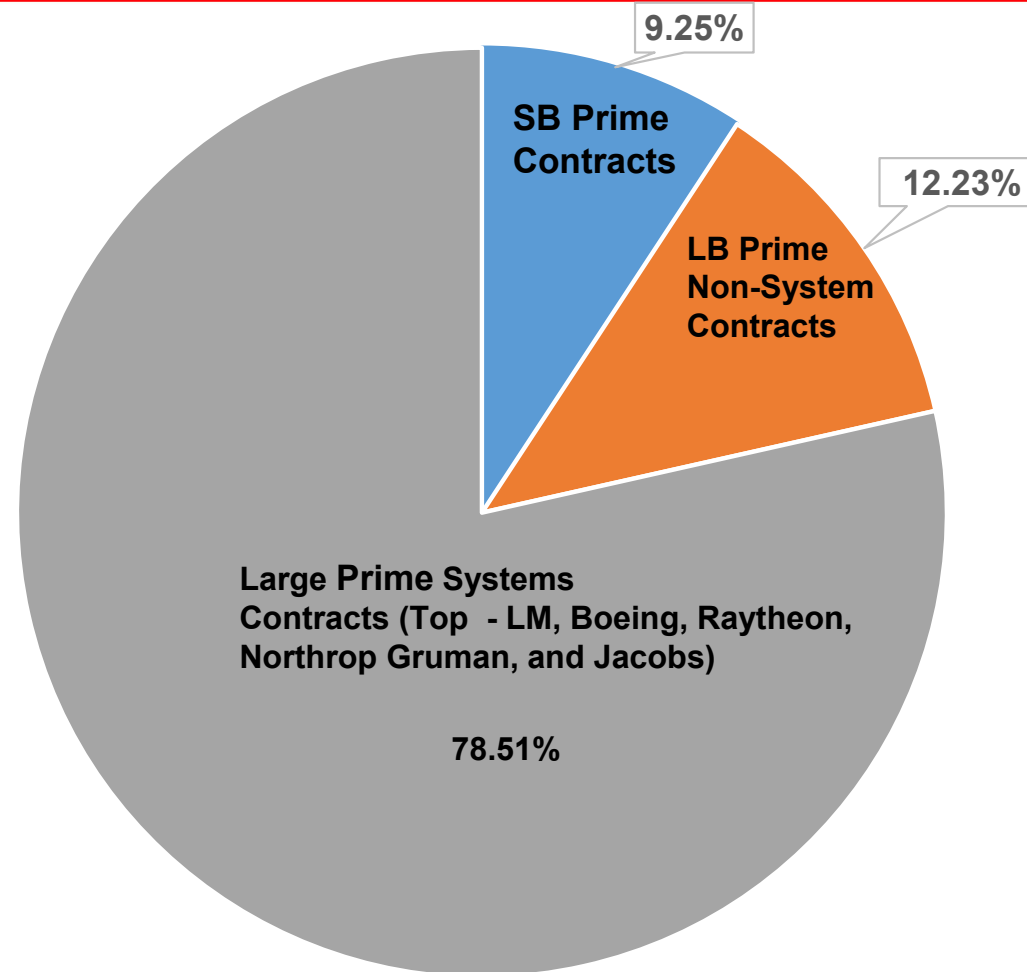

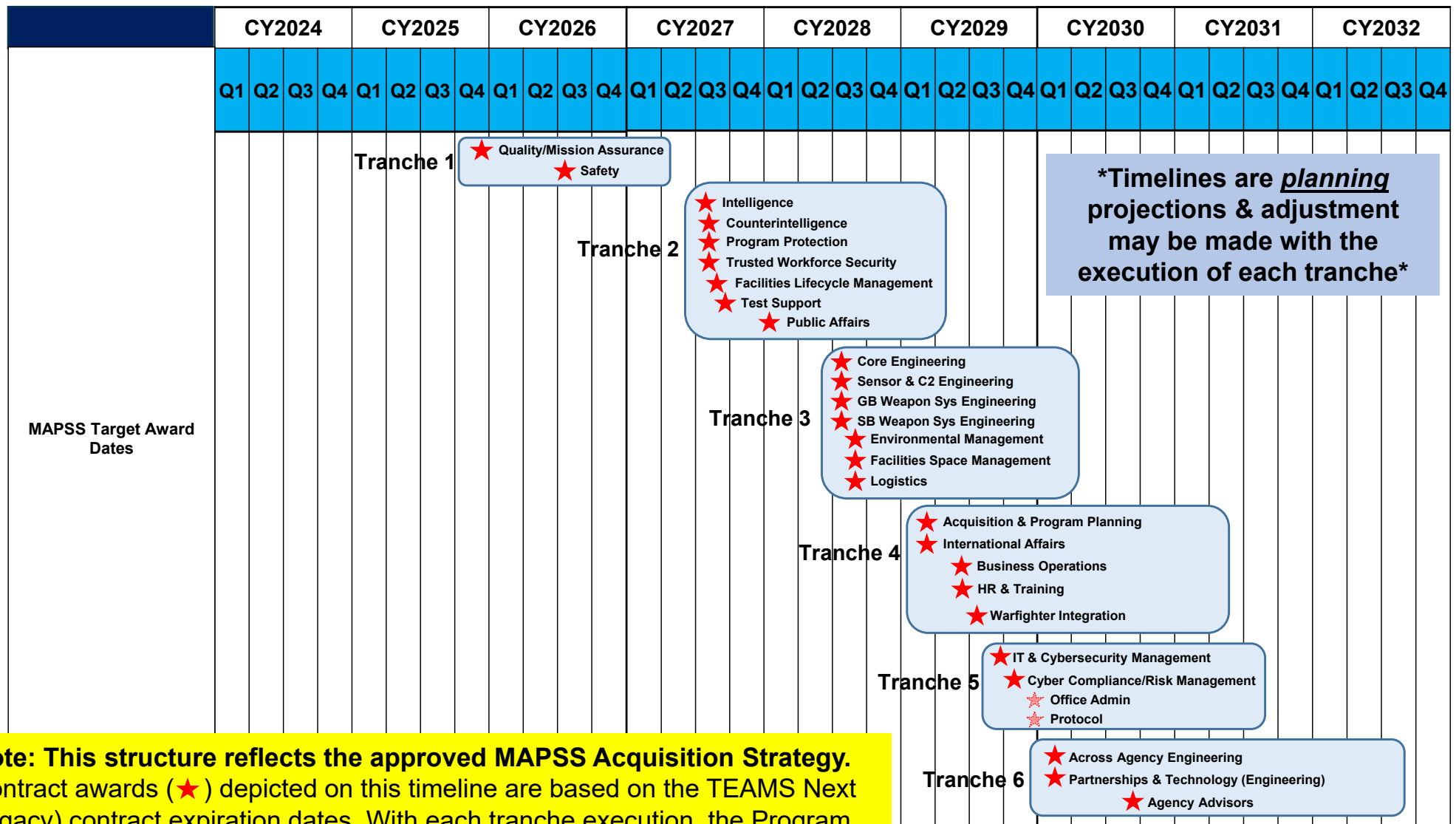
# Category Management (CM)/Spend Under Management Considerations
